The month of August is dedicated to **The Immaculate Heart of Mary**. Like July, the entire month falls within the liturgical season of **Ordinary Time**. We celebrate 2 feasts this month, the Transfiguration of the Lord (August 4) and The Assumption (August 15). The purpose

of the Transfiguration was to encourage and strengthen the Apostles who were depressed by Jesus' prediction of His own Passion and Death. The Apostles were made to understand that His redeeming work has two phases: The Cross, and glory—that we shall be glorified with Him only if we first suffer with Him. The Assumption completes God's work in Mary, since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The Assumption looks to eternity and gives us hope that we, too, will follow Our Lady when our life is ended.
