The next blood drive is Sunday, 07/30/2017 from 7:30am to 1:30pm. We are excited to announce that our drive, by popular demand, has been "upgraded" to get 3 automation donating machines. These are much faster than the older machines! That means that on many different perspectives, you will be able to get in, donate your DOUBLE RED donation, and be on your way much faster than in the past! The added machine insures less wait time to get in. And the new technology machines mean that your DOUBLE donation is cut down by almost HALF of older machines, from 50 minutes down to about 25 minutes. The END result is that your "double" donation takes now about the same time as your "single" whole blood donation. And speaking from experience, the double-red donation process is LESS taxing on my bodily system, since water and unneeded fluids are placed BACK in your body.

Such a deal, eh?!! Donating double in the same amount of time as whole blood, for LESS strain on your body!! (Also note: the medical provider can use the blood immediately... They don't have to filter it and process otherwise.) Please, talk it up among your family and friends!!
