"Ordinary Time" does not mean that the days are not important. It simply refers to the two periods that fall outside of the major liturgical seasons (Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter). The first period of Ordinary time is right after the Christmas season (first Sunday after January 6) and runs through Ash Wednesday when Lent begins. The second period is after Pentecost Sunday and goes to the first Sunday of Advent which is also when the liturgical year begins.

June also marks the end of our fraternal year. During our business meeting on June 4th, we will elect our new officers for the 2018 – 2019 fraternal year.
