





St. Basil Council 4204 of Sugar Land, Texas, is offering three individual college EDUCATION GRANTS in the amount of \$1,500.00 each to 2016 graduating high school seniors. To apply for this educational grant, the applicant must submit a handwritten or typed essay to Grand Knight Lloyd J. Waguespack, Jr. on or before May 10, 2016. The committee will review each essay and select the winners. The following rules will apply to the awarding of the grants:

- 1. The essay must be HANDWRITTEN or TYPED
- 2. The essay must be postmarked or hand delivered by May 10, 2016 to: Grand Knight Lloyd J. Waguespack, Jr., 702 Burney Road, Sugar Land, TX, 77498-2610.
- 3. The applicant's <u>NAME SHOULD APPEAR ONLY ON THE COVER SHEET</u> and there shall be no reference to your name or the names of any members of your family in your essay, <u>or you</u> <u>will be disqualified.</u>
- 4. The essay should be written in 3 SECTIONS OR PARAGRAPHS:
- SECTION I Personal history, including length of residence in the Sugar Land area, high school activities, jobs, hobbies, and community involvement.
- SECTION II Goals in life in relation to college major/minor and desired vocation after college graduation; and the name of the institution you plan to attend.
- SECTION III Respond to the following: "Why are the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy so important to the Christian life?"

### **The Importance of Religious Freedom**

Fifty years ago the Second Vatican Council released its document on the importance of religious freedom, titled Dignitatis Humanae. Today, religious freedom is seriously restricted in countries around the world, while at home, much work is being done to protect our First Amendment right to religious freedom from erosion.

Looking at the case of the Little Sisters of the Poor, whose religious freedom case is currently being considered by the Supreme Court, and at examples worldwide, this new video — The Right to Religious Liberty — explains why the Second Vatican Council's document remains so important and why protecting our right to religious liberty is critical to every person's fundamental freedom.

### **Fortnight for Freedom**

From June 21 to July 4, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) will host its annual Fortnight for Freedom under the theme "Witnesses to Freedom." In support of this theme, the USCCB will highlight 14 men and women around the world who bear witness to authentic freedom in Christ.

As faithful Catholic American citizens, we encourage your council to work with your pastors to be fully engaged in this special celebration. For suggestions on simple activities, please visit the USCCB's Fortnight for Freedom website. Additionally, we encourage you to share the USCCB-produced 10-minute video on the importance of religious liberty that is available on the website. This could be done at a council meeting or as part of a larger parish or community celebration of the fortnight.

You can also order Knights of Columbus religious freedom signs (13"x 20") for use at any rallies or marches for religious freedom sponsored by your council or held in your area. The signs say "Respect Religious Freedom" (#10041) and "Defend the First Amendment" (#10042). Order online at Knights Gear or send a Supply Requisition (Form #1) by mail or fax (1-800-266-6340) to the Supply Department. The cost is \$10 per 100 signs, which includes shipping and handling.
