reception/social starts at 4:00 pm; the ceremony starts promptly at 5:00 pm and the meal is immediately after the ceremony completion. Awards are then presented.

On Saturday October 22 there was a 1st, 2nd and 3rd degree conducted in the St. Theresa Family Life Center. Brother Clayton Hughes joined during the 1st Degree. On Monday November 14, a bus is going to visit the grave of deceased brother Deacon Frank Cromer. The bus will leave after the 8:30am Mass. The Office of the Dead will be recited at either his grave or in the church at the cemetery. Following prayers lunch will at Frank's Restaurant. I estimate we should be back no later than 4:00pm. Dues notices for 2017 dues will be mailed in early December; dues of \$36 for most members and \$10 for Honorary members. 
