ST. THERESA PRO-LIFE MOVEMENT PRAYER LINES

Our parish prayer lines for '40 Days for Life' are already up for this fall. Fr. David is giving precious space in the parish bulletin to inform parishioners and requesting they participate.

The address is: 8200 Wednesbury Lane, Sharpstown 77074

Directions are: N...59/69 feeder road, rt. Gessner St., (go 1 block), lft. Tybor Dr., (Until street ends in 3 blocks.), lft.

Wednesbury Lane, (one block), Park on the curb beyond the man in the chair and the street sign.

A St. Theresa Knight will be there to greet and assist you.

With 493 prayer lines nationwide this is the largest campaign ever.

Our parish campaign runs from September 25th to November 3rd.

Our parish is responsible for Mondays and Thursdays 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m.

Come with friends and car pool. Pray the rosary for 1 or 2 hours.

Your presence has a profound effect in saving the quality of the lives of the pregnant women and the lives of the babies in their wombs. Abortionists complain in letters and e-mails to their home office that @75% of women with appointments do not show up for abortions on days when you are on the prayer line.

You are successful when:

Pregnant women slow their cars down to see you and read your signs and then choose to drive away from their scheduled abortion appointments.

Pregnant women park on the parking lot but stay in their cars debating their decision in light of your presence and joyful prayer line and helpful signs and then choose to drive away.

Pregnant women park and walk back and forth glancing at your presence and signs then return to their car and drive away.

Pregnant women walk to the door of the facility then look back at you on the prayer line and either return to their car to drive away or walk across the parking lot and street up to you for help. (A trained woman Prayer Advocate will come to your side to assist her.)

Pregnant women enter the doors for an abortion and chose to leave without an abortion and instead go to their car and drive away.

Thanks to Prayer Lines nationwide abortions have been dropping every year since 1987. Yet 1/3 of every generation since Roe v Wade has been aborted.

As a Catholic please follow the request of your pastor, priests and deacons and join the St. Theresa Prayer line this fall campaign. Lives depend on you.
