## **Financial Secretary's Report**

In July we started the 2017-2018 Fraternal Year. The Council has a new State Charity goal and you can help by donating \$20 to Texas State Charities and receive a state charity pin. Contact the FS Pete Muceus at a meeting or send him a check saying you would like a charity pin.

There was a 1st Degree in the Hall during the August 15 meeting and there are 11 newly initiated members but none for Council 4204.

The State Council has a fund raising activity that also provides monetary prizes for 10 weeks during the pro football season. It is an online discount webpage coupon that also includes 10 weekly pro football games. The cost of an individual card is \$10 for 10 weeks of games. The 10 weekly prizes range from \$400 to \$40. ## A Special Thank You From Our Blood Drive Coordinator

It is indeed a GOOD DAY, Brother Knights of Columbus! Regarding our last blood drive on 07/31/2017, any KC's or parishioners contributing, whether working or donating, or both, on our last BLOOD DRIVE on 07/30/2017, was PART OF ST. THERESA Catholic Church HISTORY, regarding our blood drives!! To my knowledge, at least from recorded history, we made history and conducted our BEST DRIVE EVER in terms of units collected! We hit a record HIGH of 62 units collected! Our highest recorded drive, since I took over drives in November 2006, was 51 units. I would add that this "increase" only, was about in the "range" of total average units collected on the bus when I took the drive chair over in 2006! Wow! We have come a long way in saving lives! For every unit collected, depending on what it is, whether plasma, whole blood, or red cells only, GC blood center tells us we save about 2 to 3 lives. Following that through, we saved a range of 120 to 180 lives last drive!

We should pause and thank Almighty God and give him Praise and Glory, for his generous giving people! That is a staggering statistic, when you think about it. From a personal perspective, I experienced first-hand a good friend Ron who suffered much internal bleeding from a traumatic accident in early to mid-June this year. It warms my heart and gives me a tear in my eye to think that me, AND YOU WORKERS and DONORS, played a REAL part in very possibly saving his life, or replenishing the blood supply that saved his life! Just think of the others! Wow. Your blood is shipped wherever it is needed! My hat is off to all you brave donors and workers otherwise! To some, we understand it is more difficult than others to donate. But, make no mistake, we gladly accept any contribution from your efforts to our drive!! We look forward to brighter drives ahead, saving even MORE lives than ever!
