Grand Knight's Report



Brother Knights,

I continue to pray that this newsletter finds you and your family healthy and safe! As we enter the sixth month of this pandemic, we will continue to practice social distancing, wear masks (or other facial covering), and provide no meal at our meetings until further notice. The month of September is dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrows, whose memorial the Church celebrates on September 15. September falls during the liturgical season known as Ordinary Time and continues to be represented by the liturgical color green. As in all Ordinary Time, the Liturgy does not focus on one mystery of Christ but views the mystery of Christ in all its aspects. We follow the life of Christ through the Gospels and focus on the teachings and parables of Jesus and what it means for us to be a follower of Christ. During Ordinary Time we can concentrate more on the Saints and imitate their holiness as Christ's followers.

Labor Day, this year, is on September 7 and as a result our regular council meeting will be moved to Tuesday, September 8, 7:00pm. Labor Day is a creation of the labor movement in the late 19th century and is dedicated to the social and economic achievements of American workers. The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. The Central Labor Union held its second Labor Day holiday just a year later, on September 5, 1883. By 1894, 23 more states had adopted the holiday, and on June 28, 1894, President Grover Cleveland signed a law making the first Monday in September of each year a national holiday.

I would like to thank those Brother Knights for their time, support, commitment, and effort in helping Catholic Charities with their food distribution on Saturday, August 29. It was hot, but we got the job done! Brothers, this is an every-other week event at Catholic Charities (next distribution is on September 12, 9:30am-3:30pm).
