To apply for this scholarship, the applicant must submit a handwritten or typed essay to Grand Knight Jeff Schumann on or before April 15, 2011. The scholarship committee will review each essay and select the winners. The following rules will apply to the awarding of the scholarship:

- 1. The essay must be **HANDWRITTEN** or **Typed**
- 2. The essay must be postmarked or hand delivered by **April 15, 2011** to: **Grand Knight, Jeff Schumann, 702 Burney Road, Sugar Land, TX. 77498**.
- 3. The applicant's <u>NAME SHOULD APPEAR **ONLY** ON THE COVER SHEET</u> and there shall be no reference to your name or the names of any members of your family in your essay, <u>or you will be disqualified.</u>
- 4. The contest is open to the children or grandchildren of all Knights of Columbus who are members in good standing of Council 4204, all Columbian Squires of Circle 3058, Junior Catholic Daughters of Court 2211, and all registered members of St. Theresa's Catholic Church of Sugar Land.
- 5. The essay should be written in 3 SECTIONS OR PARAGRAPHS:

SECTION I Personal History, including length of residence in the Sugar Land area, high

school activities, jobs, hobbies, and community involvement.

SECTION II Goals in life in relation to college major/minor and desired vocation after college graduation,

name of institution you plan to attend.

SECTION III Respond to the following: "The Responsibility of the Catholic Citizen

in a Free Society"

Columbus Club

(Reprint by request)

What is the Columbus Club? Why do we need a separate group of Knights that manage our property, pay the utility bills and Taxes? Yes taxes, at this time we pay taxes on our property just like you pay on your house, car ETC. I will talk about taxes a little later in this article.

To begin one must understand that the Knights of Columbus is a fraternal organization. We are bound by the by-laws of the National and State organizations. The Knights of Columbus cannot hold title to any property nor generate wealth. It can raise money for charity and good works in our community. This is why we have a Columbus Club. The name of the organization is the Columbus Club of Sugar Land. I will refer to it as the "Club". This corporation holds title to the property and everything that the KC uses and or has. The Club pays the bills such as electric, gas, ETC. Like any corporation the Club has a board of directors. One of those directors is your Grand Knight which is mandated. In our club we have 12 elected directors beside the Grand Knight. They serve three year terms. Four are (re)elected each year in June. In this way you only have 1/3 of your directors that are new yearly.

The Club is the group that can sign a note for improvements on the hall, buy supplies and fish fryers and so forth. One of the things your club is working on is applying for tax exempt status so we do not have to pay county, school, state or city taxes. To do this your Club created a third organization that we call the CCBS, the officers of which report to the Club. The CCBS leases the bar and holds all profits from all alcohol sales. The CCBS pays the Club for the use of the facility. Neither the CCBS nor the Club can retain any profit by our bylaws. All profit, with some minor exceptions, that is earned must be given back to the 4204 to spend on charity. So you see it is a big circle. The CCBS rents the hall out to the public and makes a profit on alcohol sales. All profits are paid to the Club which pays the bills. Any money left over is paid to 4204 which uses it for charity work. The Club and the CCBS exist under the direction of 4204. In fact, the President of the Club reports to the Grand Knight.

All members of council 4204 are members of the Club. 4204 elects the directors as described above. The directors take office on July 1 of each year just like your council officers. The 13 directors then elect a president, vice president, secretary and treasurer from the ranks of the directors. The Directors also elect the president, vice president and treasurer of the CCBS. The CCBS officers do not have to be a Club director but in most cases will be. The President appoints a Maintenance Manager, Leasing Manager and Hall Manager that report directly to him. These three managers can be any 4204 3rd degree members. In most cases they will be a current or past Club Director but it is not mandatory.

So think about all this, come to the next Club meeting and get involved. Think about running for a Club Director position. The new directors are elected annually in May or June.
