KC Insurance update

Let Me Think About It

Many times people will delay the purchase of needed life insurance because they assume there is no rush. A recent study of claims paid on Knights of Columbus life policies reveals that in 2010 there were a number of claims paid on plans that were in force less than 12 months*. The leading causes of death were accidents, heart disease and cancer. The claims paid were from 20 states and six provinces of Canada.

Policies In Force Less Than Twelve Months

The chart below shows the number of months and days in force, what the person did, his age, cause of death and finally the amount paid.
