Saturday, 06 October 2012, **March of the Surviving Youth (MOTSY)** - Catholic Charismatic Center (CCC), Mass - **8:15 a.m.** - **This is the preeminent Archdiocese Youth Pro-Life event in the year.** It is sponsored by the Catholic Organization of Life (COOL), the only Archdiocese-sponsored youth Pro-Life organization.
