Long-Term Care Plan to Dramatically change July 1, 2014

Our Agency received word May 28th, 2014 that there is going to a dramatic change to our Long Term Care premiums and options. This change is estimated to take effect July 1st this year. Current policy holders will not be affected by these changes. Applications need to be completed as soon as possible.

If you have been on the fence about applying for you or your wife, now is the time to get the details. The application process is very short and easy, and in most cases the only underwriting involved is a phone interview.
